Subject: Mid-term exam procedure

Here I provide a few details on taking the mid-term exam for the CAETE ECEN 5797 students.

1) The exam is a 1-week take home exam. You are not allowed to collaborate or discuss the exam with anyone, except for Prof. Zane in case any clarifications are required on the problem statements. You are welcome to review the textbook and your prior assignments and solutions when taking the exam, but are not expected to use or require other resources.

2) You must complete and turn-in Homeworks 1 - 6 prior to taking the exam. You are also welcome to complete HW #7 prior to taking the exam if you wish (the same as on-campus students), but it is not required to take the exam.

3) The exam will be posted online with password protection starting Friday October 16. To take the exam

- * e-mail the grader, Ms. Jieyeon Choi (Jieyeon.Choi@colorado.edu), with the date that you want to start the exam. Send this request at least one day before the date that you want to start the exam (and cc. Prof. Zane).

- * On the day you request, Ms. Choi will e-mail you the password to download the exam

- * You must turn in your solution within 1 week after receiving the password:

by midnight via e-mail or fax or postmarked via US-mail (e.g. receive password Friday, return by 11:59pm the following Friday night)

- * Turn in your solution to Prof. Zane (via e-mail, fax or US-mail)

4) I expect the CAETE students to finish the exam no later than Friday October 30, 1 week after the on campus students. Contact Prof. Zane with special requests.
